Seminole County, Florida — As Florida faces back-to-back hurricanes I was not surprised when I saw our current representative, **Cory Mills, VOTED AGAINST FUNDING FOR FEMA** which is desperately needed for hurricane victims and relief efforts.

Even worse, my opponent immediately went on a photo op tour to capture headlines with the people in the disaster-stricken areas who he voted against funding just before Hurricane Helene hit Florida, Georgia, South Carolina, North Carolina, and parts of Tennessee and Virginia.

Right now, our district (FL CD7) is in the cone and direct path of Hurricane Milton. Many residents across our district and state are either evacuating or seeking shelter and are in desperate need. We need leaders — not self-serving followers — representing us in Congress. While my opponent likes to talk and pose for staged action shots, I spent the last 48 hrs. filling up and delivering hundreds of sandbags to those in our district not able to do it themselves.

Now, make no mistake, Mills will likely show up in the aftermath of this hurricane for a photo op, but where was he when it mattered most for us? We know he was not in our district since he doesn't even live in Florida. Not in DC fighting for Floridians — rather he was voting against funding for FEMA before going back to his multi-million-dollar home in the DC area.

As a representative in Congress, I'll always advocate for the interests of all in our community — regardless of party affiliation — and bring people together across party lines to advance common sense, collaborative solutions to the challenges we face here in Florida and across our nation.

While I know I'm the only native Floridian and hometown candidate in this race, even I would expect a little more from “Missing in Action” Mills, but guess he thinks FLCD7 voters are easy to fool and won't notice.
